To eliminate this problem, StreamQuik[™] is pleased to introduce SkipLink[™], a simple no-app-required solution which enables companies and organizations to send link-free texts and email messages to recipients without requiring them to click, tap, or scan anything.

When a text or email sender sends a message with an embedded SkipLink code from StreamQuik and message recipients enter this code into SkipLink, SkipLink will then deliver message recipients to the sender's website. SkipLink users can then access the same

message details (previously provided by clicking on links in the sender's message) from the message sender's website instead without clicking, tapping, or scanning anything in the sender's messages.

Because of the severity of the FBI's don't-click warning, companies and organizations are intensifying their efforts to "flag" incoming texts and emails containing links to avoid the risks and potential liability.

By sending link-free messages with embedded SkipLink codes, message senders can boost the chances of their messages being delivered (no links to filter) while giving recipients a way to access sender's information even without opening their emails—ideal for those who are averse to using email.
